How to obtain Italian Champion title



For the breeds that require working trial there are two options:

1) 6 CAC obtained in open or intermedia class or in working class

Required working proof for the specific breed (list is in attach)
Two of these CACs has to be obtained at a Club show or a Specialty Dog
show

One of these CAC has to be obtained at a National show Other CAC has to be obtained at an International show The 6 CAC has to be obtained from 5 different Judges

2) 5 CAC all in working class

Required working proof for the specific breed (list is in attach)
Two of these CACs has to be obtained at a Club show or a Specialty Dog show

One of these CAC has to be obtained at a National show Other CAC has to be obtained at an International show The 5 CAC has to be obtained from 5 different Judges

For breed that does not require working trial:

6 CAC, obtained in open or intermedia class

Two of this CAC has to be obtained at a Club show or at a Speciality show 1 of this CAC has to be obtained at a National Dog show Other CAC has to be obtained at an International Dog show The 6 CAC has to be obtained under 5 different Judges

ATTENTION:

CAC is not available in Ch Class in Italy. Only CACIB is permitted in this class. Because there is only one CAC for the Intermedia Class and the Open Class, the winners of those two classes compete for the CAC. There is the CAC for the Working Class as well.

There are **additional requirements** for some breeds. For example, for the Schnauzer or Pinscher, you must pass the Club selection in order to obtain the Italian Champion title; thus, before beginning an Italian Championship, first contact the Italian specialized Breed Clubs for more detailed information.
